## Quick Facts

- 14 women, 6 men and 10 children are killed by a member of their family every year
- One child every three days is hospitalised from child abuse
- The economic cost of family violence is estimated at \$1.2 to \$5.8 billion per year
- These are strongly co-related and complex pressing problems that require integrated solutions to improve outcomes for families.
